

<u>Israel at War – MDC Media update</u>

November 23, 2023

Dear Friends and Colleagues,

Early this week, there were reports of a <u>breakthrough</u> for a deal to release approximately 50 of the Israeli hostages, primarily children and their mothers, in exchange for Palestinians minors for females held in Israeli prisons. This exchange is expected to unfold over the course of a four-day cease-fire, with 10-12 Israeli hostages released each day. Humanitarian aid is also expected to be delivered into Gaza during the four-day cease-fire. The deal follows a week of fierce fighting in northern Gaza, escalation on Israel's northern border, an Extraordinary Arab-Islamic summit in Riyadh, and international pressure for a post-war plan for Gaza.
